Using method

- 1. Before use, please check whether the product can be started. If it cannot be started, please charge the product with the attached charging line before use.
- 2. Place the massager over your knee.
- 3. Press and hold the switch key for 2 seconds, the buzzer drops once, and the default temperature of startup is 40°C.
- 4. When powering on the product, press the "+" warming key once, add it to 60°C and then press the "+" key, it "beeps" twice (digitally unchanged); press "-" temperature reducing key once to reduce it to 40°C, it "beeps" twice (digitally unchanged), and the temperature range is (40°C 45°C 55°C 60°C).

- 5. When powering on the product, press M massage mode key, it "beeps" once, the product switches in turn between three massage modes (● blue light gentle massage, ☐ green light soothing massage, ☐ white light strong massage) and off mode, respectively, and the indicator lights correspond to blue green white turnoff off, respectively, and a warning is dropped for each switching mode buzzer.
- 6. After powering on, press M key for 2 s to enter screen lock mode, M indicator light is red, and it is impossible to switch mode and add or subtract temperature in screen lock state. Press and hold for 2 seconds to unlock (no light display), and a single "beep" will sound each time the screen lock/unlock mode is toggled.
- 7. In the start-up state, press and hold the power button, the buzzer "beeps" once, and the product will shut down and turn off all the indicators.

Charging function

When the product is no power, M lamp is and flashes three times and "beep" two or three times. When the product is charged, the respiratory lamp shows green light, and the green light is always on when it is fully charged. If the product needs automatic shutdown during charging, it can not be used while charging.

Working time

The default time for startup of the product is 20 minutes. When switching off the heating temperature or vibration mode within 20 minutes, it turns off timely and all functions stop, the light off and it shuts down.


Cleaning and maintenance

Host care


It is necessary to properly protect the display screen of the host with touch function. For cleaning the host, please use soft cloth to wipe it.

Failure handling instructions

If the product can't function properly, check that the following condition has occurred. If our advice can't solve the problem, return the product to your distributor for repair.

1. Knee protection products cannot be started

Cause: Product remains connected to a domestic power outlet; battery is depleted; power button is not pressed securely.

Solution: Remove the charging wire from the body; charge; press the power switch key firmly until you press it into place.

2. Charging indicator does not on

Cause: The USB charging cable is not properly plugged into the power outlet.

Solution: Plug the USB charging cable into the power outlet correctly.

3. Can only be used for a few minutes even if it has just been charged

Cause: End of battery life (approx. 5 years)

Solution: Consult your distributor (do not replace the battery on your own)

4. Body does not heat

Cause: This product may not function properly when used outside the recommended ambient temperature range.

Solution: Use within the recommended operating temperature range of $0 \sim 40^{\circ}$ C.

5. Product stops working during run

Cause: Battery has run out; after about 15 minutes, the product stops working automatically.

Solution: charge under low battery.

Storage requirements
